

POW/MIA REPORT... Ray Calore, Chairman




Operation Homecoming — the Vietnam prisoner exchange — brought 591 U.S. POWs home. The first C-141, later named the *Hanoi Taxi*, departed the Hanoi airport on February 12, 1973. A total of 54 flights

from Hanoi and Saigon ended on April 4th of the same year. At that point, President Nixon stated "All of our brave POWs are back home." Those words virtually doomed any POWs left behind or kept by the enemy for bargaining purposes. They called it "Peace With Honor". There was no Peace, and the only Honor is with those of us who fought that war.




