Comrades, here is the next segment of the National VFW Legislative Priorities.

To review the entries submitted in previous 846 newsletters, go to www.vfw.org.

Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs:

- Consider treatment of presumptive conditions as a claim for disability compensation.
- Extend Persian Gulf War disability compensation eligibility beyond 2021 and to Afghanistantheater veterans, and reform the relevant Disability Benefits Questionnaire.
- Establish presumptive disability compensation benefits for hearing loss, tinnitus, TBI, blast survivors, and for health conditions associated with toxic exposures.
- Require VA to accept private medical evidence in lieu of VA examinations.
- Increase burial allowances to account for inflation and include spouses' information on all headstones.
- Authorize more than one adaptive automotive grant for disabled veterans.
- Make the VA National Service Life Insurance competitive with private health insurance policies.
- Update regulations and laws governing claims to account for digital claims processing.
- Improve accuracy of disability compensation claims related to military sexual trauma.
- Expand VA wartime benefits to early Vietnam veterans.
- Transfer control of the Mare Island Naval Cemetery to the National Cemetery Administration.

SPECIAL FROM VFW NATIONAL HQ, March 19, 2020:

KANSAS CITY, MO. - As a new wave of scams surface in an attempt to exploit coronavirus fears, the VFW would like to remind all of its members to exercise extreme caution in providing personal information during any unsolicited call. Most recently, a VFW member reported receiving a call from an individual identifying himself as a VFW representative and was asked to provide credit card information in exchange for a \$100 gift card. This is a scam.

If you do receive a call from an individual claiming to be a VFW representative who is requesting personally identifiable information, ask that they confirm your VFW membership number. If they're unable to do so, hang up.

If you have worked with the VFW on a VA benefits claim, and you receive a suspicious call regarding your claim, ask the caller to verify your VA claim number before sharing any critical information.
