LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES—HEALTH CARE

Last month we listed the VFW's Legis. Priorities pertaining to "Military Quality of Life." Now here is the list of VFW priorities for Health Care:

- Reduce the number of service members and veterans who die by suicide.
- Preserve the integrity of TRICARE.
- Properly implement VA and DOD health IT systems.
- Strengthen care and research for mental health and traumatic brain injury (TBI).
- Improve programs and services for women veterans.
- Research and effectively treat health conditions associated with toxic exposures.
- Eliminate copayment requirements for preventive medicines.
- Research the efficacy of medical cannabis.
- Expand telehealth services.
- * Expand nursing home eligibility.

U.S. POSTAL SERVICE ISSUES "HEALING PTSD" STAMP. HEALING

With this semipostal stamp, the U.S. Postal Service will raise funds to help treat those impacted by post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD). The stamp features a photo illustration of a green plant sprouting from the ground, which is covered in fallen leaves. The image is in-

tended to symbolize the PTSD healing process, growth and hope.

The 65-cent price of the semi-postal stamp pays for the price of a regular first-class postage, plus an amount to the National Center for PTSD Studies, distributed by the V.A.

POW/MIA REPORT...

(This is a reprint of the report from last January. Why? Because the facts don't change, even with the passing of time.):

On January 27, 1973, representatives from North and South Vietnam, the United States and the National Liberation Front (Charlie) signed the Paris Peace Accords, which marked the end of U.S. involvement in the Vietnam War. Secretary of State Henry Kissinger referred to it as "peace with honor." Remember that phrase? It's still good for a laugh, or at least a few tears. One of the major betrayals of the agreement was the return of American POWs. From February to April 1973,

"Operation Homecoming" brought the return of 591 American POWs through Hanoi, even though many more were expected to return. Others, it is speculated, were held back in anticipation of \$4.25 billion in "war reparations" promised in a secret agreement by President Richard Nixon, but was never paid.

And so it began, the Vietnam POW/MIA issue as we know it today. January 27th is the anniversary of that milestone event, and the questions that were unanswered then remain unanswered today.
