POW/MIA REPORT... RAY CALORE, Chairman



Comrades, It's time again to be reminded of the anniversary this month of the Paris Peace Accords, signed on January 27, 1973.

The "Peace Accords" officially ended U.S. involvement in the Vietnam War.

The preliminary peace talks began in 1968, with the chief negotiators being Henry Kissinger (U.S.) and Le Duc Tho (Hanoi). Progress was frustratingly slow: For example, eight months into the talks, the only thing the two sides had agreed on was the shape of the conference table.

The talks continued for five years, as the war raged on and the bombing continued. Eventually, on January 27, 1973, a final agreement was reached, which Dr. Kissinger called "peace with honor." It is probable that both Kissinger and Le Duc Tho anticipated that the terms of the agreement would be broken by both sides. Specifically, the complete return of American prisoners of war, and the payment of \$4.5 Billion in "reparation aid" promised by President Nixon in a secret communication to V.N. Prime Minister Pham Van Dong. The money was not paid, and all of our POWs did not come home.

Later that year, in the fall of 1973, the Nobel Committee in Oslo, Norway, awarded the Nobel Peace Prize jointly to Henry Kissinger and Le Duc Tho, the chief negotiators in the peace process. Kissinger gladly accepted his award. Le Duc Tho refused his award. Perhaps he understood that the Vietnam War was not truly over.

Meanwhile, we continued to bask in the so-called "peace with honor", and the beginning of the Vietnam POW/MIA issue.

VA's GULF WAR ILLNESS PRESUMPTIVE CONDITIONS

VA presumes certain chronic, unexplained symptoms that exist for six months or more are related to Gulf War service without regard to cause.

These presumptive illnesses must have appeared during active duty in Southwest Asia since Aug. 2, 1990, and be at least 10 percent disabling.

These illnesses include:

- Myalgic Encephalomyelitis or Chronic Fatigue Syndrome.
- Fibromyalgia, which causes muscle and soft tissue pain.
- Functional gastrointestinal disorders.
- Undiagnosed illnesses, such as weight loss, fatigue, joint pain and cardiovascular disease.

Gulf War veterans who have any of these presumptive conditions do not need to prove a connection between their military service and illnesses to receive disability compensation.
