POW/MIA REPORT... RAY CALORE, Chairman



Wichita, Kansas, WWII soldier's remains identified and brought home.

WASHINGTON – The Defense POW/MIA Accounting Agency (DPAA) announced today that U.S. Army Pvt. Pearl F. Barrow, 36, of Wichita, Kansas, killed dur-

ing World War II, was accounted for Jan. 9, 2020

In November 1944, Barrow was assigned to Company F, 12th Infantry Regiment, 4th Infantry Division. His unit was engaged in battle with German forces near Hürtgen, Germany, when he was reported as killed in action on Nov. 20. Because of the fighting, his body was unable to be recovered.

Following the end of the war, the American Graves Registration Command (AGRC) was tasked with investigating and recovering missing American personnel in Europe. To identify Barrow's remains, scientists from DPAA used dental and anthropological analysis and other methods. Barrow will be buried in his hometown. The date has yet to be determined.
